

Department of Linguistics Articulation Agreement

University of Utah College of Humanities | Salt Lake Community College School of Humanities and Social Sciences

This Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into as of the last signature date below by and between Salt Lake Community College, a body politic and corporate of the State of Utah and a public institution of higher education and the Department of Linguistics at the University of Utah, a body politic and corporate of the State of Utah and a public institution of higher education. The purpose of this Agreement is to articulate the terms of collaboration between the Department of Linguistics at the University of Utah (UU) and the English Department at Salt Lake Community College (SLCC) that will begin August 1, 2019, all as more specifically described herein.

The Department of Linguistics at the University of Utah and the English Department in the School of Humanities and Social Sciences at SLCC agree to the articulation of transfer credit as outlined in this agreement.

The following courses agreed upon to articulate:

Students who begin their study of Linguistics at Salt Lake Community College will need to complete the following requirements in order to earn their BA in Linguistics at the University of Utah:

SLCC Track for the University of Utah Linguistics BA Major (36 credits)

Courses taken at Salt Lake Community College
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduction to the Field (3 credits): Take one of the following ENGL 1200 (Introduction to Linguistics) (3 credits) -OR- ENGL 1069 (Bad Words and Taboo Terms) (3 credits) • Electives (9 credits): Take up to three of the following ENGL 2030 (Language in US Society) (3 credits) ENGL 2220 (World Englishes) (3 credits) ENGL 2475 (Language Myths) (3 credits)
Bridge course (U of U Continuing Education course taken at SLCC prior to transfer to U of U)
LING 3510 (Grammar and Stylistics) (3 credits)

Courses taken at the University of Utah

- Theoretical Foundations (6 credits): Take both of the following
LING 4010 (Introduction to Phonetics and Phonology) (3 credits)
LING 4020 (Introduction to Syntax) (3 credits)

- Theoretical Depth (3 credits): Take one of the following
LING 5011 (Intermediate Phonetics and Phonology) (3 credits)
-OR-
LING 5021 (Intermediate Syntax) (3 credits)

- Capstone (3 credits): Take the following course
LING 5900 (Senior Capstone) (3 credits)

- Electives: at least 3 courses (9 credits)
at least 1 course (3 credits) at the 4000+ level
at least 2 courses (6 credits) at the 5000+

This agreement will be reviewed annually. Renewal will be contingent on the outcome of these reviews. This agreement will remain in effect unless terminated in writing by either institution.

Liability

Both Salt Lake Community College and the University of Utah are governmental entities under the Governmental Immunity Act, §63G-7-101 to -904 (2011), as amended (the "Act"). Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary herein, there are no indemnity obligations between these parties. Subject to and consistent with the terms of the Act, each party shall be liable only for its own negligent acts or omissions or those of its employees, officers, and agents while engaged in the performance of the obligations under this Agreement, and neither party shall have any liability whatsoever for any negligent act or omission of the other party, its employees, officers, or agents. Neither party waives any defenses or limits of liability available under the Act and other applicable law. Each party carries insurance through the State Risk Manager of the State of Utah up to the limits required by the State Risk Manager of the State of Utah and applicable law. Nothing in this Agreement shall require either party to carry different or additional insurance. It is not the intent of either party to incur by contract any liability for the operations, acts, or omissions of the other party or any third party and nothing in this Agreement shall be so interpreted or construed. In the event of any conflict, inconsistency, or discrepancy between the provisions of this paragraph and any other provisions of this Agreement, the provisions of this paragraph of the Agreement shall govern.
