Students who wish to pursue K-3 Licensure and teach in Utah must apply to the UITE and complete section (2.) K-3 Pre-licensure Courses **and** section (3.) Licensure Program Courses. Students who successfully complete sections 1,2,3 and pass the necessary examinations and realted criteria will be licensed to teach kindergarten through third grade in Utah schools.
