### **SPECIAL NOTES**

The coursework identified is guaranteed to transfer and apply to a Bachelor of Arts (BA) or a Bachelor of Science (BS) in Theatre. It is not guaranteed to count toward a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) in Theatre and would be evaluated on a course-by-course basis along with any audition, portfolio, or other requirements that the receiving institution requires of its own students. Students should check with individual institutions for their program admission and degree requirements.

Some bachelor-degree granting institutions require additional general education courses outside of the Ohio Transfer Module and students may be required to take these courses in their junior or senior year. Students will still be able to follow this pathway and complete their bachelor's degree in approximately 60 additional credit hours.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> A minimum of two semesters of foreign language should be taken if available. However, not all institutions require foreign language, so students should check with their receiving institutions. Students may choose to take additional foreign language courses. If more foreign language courses are taken, then the elective hours will be lower.
